Moving to Crawley and Worthing would be a chance to set up a specialist centre for dementia and older people

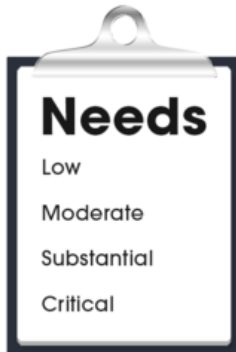
